## **Camp Rules:**

The Savannah Baptist Assembly is owned by the Savannah Baptist Association and is dedicated to the Glory of God. All who use the Assembly have a *stewardship responsibility* to care for the property and keep it clean. Please exhibit proper dress and behavior at all times.

- Wear shoes while outside. Beware of sand spurs, fire ants, and armadillo holes.
- Use a flashlight while outside at night!
- No food or drinks in the sleeping areas! If you spill liquid in any area, please wipe up immediately.
- Beds are arranged for the safety of our guests. <u>Do Not Move The Beds!</u> & <u>Do Not Add</u>
  <u>Mattresses to Top Bunks!</u>
- No Horseplay, Running, or Rough-Housing in any building.
- Report all damages to Assembly property immediately.
- Do not burn matches, incense, or candles in any building except with the expressed permission from Assembly Director.
- If gum is not in your mouth, it should be in a trash can. **Do Not** place on the walls, the floor, the furniture, or on the ground.

The small porch entrance on the side of the Big House is to be used by kitchen staff and group leaders only. Campers are to enter the Big House through the eating porch doors or the front doors of the house.

- **Do Not** sit on tables.
- Do Not put ice or liquids in a trash can. Pour out in sink or provided buckets before throwing cups and cans away.
- Do not load toilets, Flush Frequently: Allow tank to refill before flushing.
- Dispose of personal products in trash cans; Do Not flush down the toilets.

Restrooms have toilet paper in each stall; when that is used up, see your conference leader.

- Pranks or fights with shaving cream, toothpaste, water balloons, Vaseline, silly string, and paper mache' are <u>strictly prohibited</u>.
- Please keep doors closed when not in use to conserve energy and prohibit snakes from entering buildings.
- Any injury should be reported immediately to the Assembly Director.

Conference participants must remain on Assembly property for the duration of the conference. No unregistered visitors are allowed. If you have permission to leave, check out with your counselor upon departure and check in upon return.
